Course Description:

The Seniors N Tech is a computer and phone technology (PC, Mac, Android, and iPhone) course designed to assist "Senior" Tech Scholars with the latest and greatest information pertaining to their personal electronic devices and general information to keep them in the loop of the everchanging technology era. This course has an intentional mission to bridge the digital divide many participants may face due to limited or non-existent resources to effectively explain the inner workings and common use of daily devices. Throughout the courses in each quarterly session, information will be presented in a format to ensure proper and accurate knowledge is provided and assessments to evaluate the retention and mastery of the lessons. At the conclusion of each session, various certificates will be awarded based on levels of participation, mastery of skills, and abilities to demonstrate and instruct others. This course also takes general technology subjects and create an evolving increase in information levels and practical exercises each quarter and is identified as: Introductory, Fundamental, Intermediate, and Advance. Seniors N Tech is great for beginners and challenging enough for those seeking a simple refresher.

Course Levels:

Q1: Introductory :: Q2: Fundamental :: Q3: Intermediate :: Q4: Advance

- Introductory: provides preliminary information on hardware & program applications and their common uses on computers and mobile devices.
- **Fundamental**: elevates to the next level to ensure understanding on how to associate usage to daily activities.
- **Intermediate**: begins the mastery level of using technology and virtual resources to increase efficiency in executing personal tasks.
- Advance: rigorous learning environment designed to provide a higher-level user experience in knowing software, programs, and enhance the ability to articulate technology needs and self-troubleshooting any issues.
